The day trips you will embark on, during your tour, can be quite strenuous, with the average day involving, approximately, four and a half mile walks, with some standing, as you listen to your tour guide explain about your site visit.

If you have low mobility, we can accommodate this – either by arranging a low mobility tour, or by working out which sites you can visit and other options available to you when we visit a physically demanding site.

Experiencing Israel

Throughout the course of your stay, you will have the pleasure of visiting a number of world-famous places within Israel. This may include the garden of Gethsemane, the Garden Tomb, The Wailing Wall, in the Old City of Jerusalem or Herod's magnificent fortress in Masada.



If you prefer to understand the history of the Land, you may want to view the rich history available at the archaeological sites, such as Hezekiah's Tunnel in the City of David or the Tower of David museum.

You may prefer coastal regions, or to be near the seas, so you may consider a boat trip on the Sea of Galilee, scuba diving in the Red Sea, floating on the famous Dead Sea, or relaxing by the beautiful Mediterranean beaches.



For the more energetic, you may prefer to take in the Mountain ranges running through Israel. Take a hike up the Mount of Olives, sit and rest on the Mount of the Beatitudes, reflect on what is yet to be seen on the Mount of Zion.

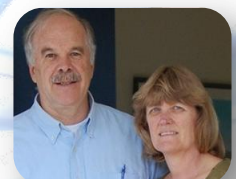

Day 5: Visit the Jordan Valley

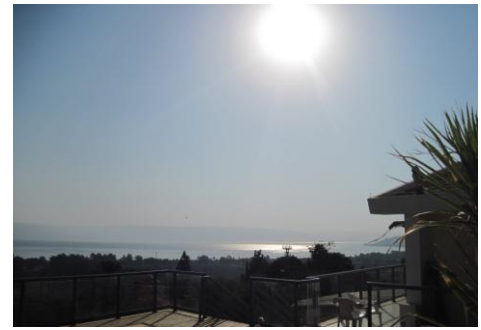
Day 6: Go into the Desert to visit En Gedi – the original site of the Dead Sea Scrolls, and then view Jericho from the Dead Sea
