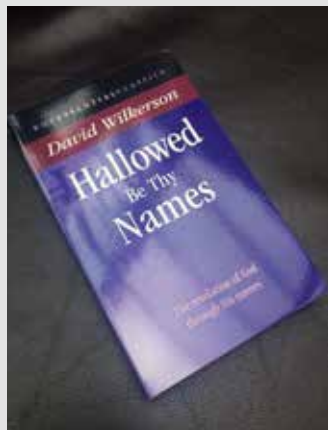

Dr. Garth Gilmour

Garth, who was appointed as Director of CMJ-Israel in October 2016, is a Biblical Archaeologist with degrees from the Hebrew University in Jerusalem and the University of Oxford. He's excavated at a number of archaeological sites in Israel, Turkey and Cyprus, including the Philistine capital cities of Ekron and Ashkelon, and has published several academic articles. He is an experienced speaker on both biblical and academic subjects, with interests ranging from the archaeology of Jerusalem to Israelite religion in Old Testament times, to studying the context of Scripture.

Rev. Ralph Goldenberg

Ralph was born in Khartoum, Sudan and was brought up an Orthodox Sephardi Jew – his maternal grandfather was Chief Rabbi of the Sudan. In 1980 he became a believer in Yeshua and eight years later felt the call to ordination in the Anglican Church becoming an Ordained Priest in 1991. As a Messianic Jew, Ralph has a passion for the Jewish roots of our faith, and is able to reveal the richness of understanding our Jewish roots in the way he speaks and communicates.

Childrens Programme with Olly Goldenberg

Olly Goldenberg has been ministering to children in churches and outside of the church for twenty years.

For fifteen of these years he led one of the largest children's ministries in Europe, with responsibility for children aged 0-14, with the ministry more than doubling in size. He saw a reversal of the trend of children leaving the church, with many of his group inviting their friends to be part of the church.

Currently he leads a ministry, together with his wife and five children, called 'Children Can.' Through modelling and training leaders, speaking in many Conferences and Churches, TV and Radio they have inspired thousands of leaders from different nations and denominations to know how to lead children from a head knowledge of God to a passionate relationship with him.

At the heart of their ministry is a passion to see children raised as disciples of Jesus.
