ABOUT CMJ ISRAEL

THANK YOU FOR YOUR INTEREST

In 1809, as Jews escaping persecution in Central Europe were arriving at the docks of London's East End, our founders, a small group of evangelical disciples of Jesus, formed the London Jews Society. Filled with compassion for the Jewish refugees and obedient to scripture, they shared their lives and time with all the Jews out of obedience to Jesus, a Jewish Messiah. The London Jews Society eventually began working in most European cities with Jewish population centers. By 1833, the Society had purchased its first property in Jerusalem, just inside Jaffa Gate where we are still working today.

During the 19th century, our organization brought the first western consulate and the first modern building to Jerusalem, then a backwater provincial town in the Ottoman Empire. We built the first Protestant church as well as other church plants, the first modern hospital, the first school for girls, agricultural training centers, and schools to teach woodworking to the Jewish people. In these settings, we served people from all ethnic groups in the Land and learned how to dialogue in a way Jewish people could understand.

Today our work and community life continue in Israel. Although our methods change with time and events, our mission remains the same. We still offer education, the best in Jerusalem, at the Anglican International School: a Christian school open to all. We have coffee shops and guesthouses based in our three community centers in Galilee, Tel Aviv/Jaffa, and Jerusalem, where believers in Jesus offer loving hospitality.



Our locations in Tel Aviv and Jerusalem display history that most Israelis have neither heard nor read: the contribution Christians made to the Jewish people and their country's foundation. Locals come, buy coffee, receive a lecture/tour of the property, and see artifacts and models (on view nowhere else) built or discovered by our staff in the 19th century. Most importantly, they ask questions such as "Why do you do this?", "Why are you here?" We also host congregations that speak multiple languages, Bible teaching tours, our historic Christ Church congregation, and a Mercy Fund that serves the poor and disadvantaged around us.

Recently, the Lord has shown us what he wants for our future. Just as WWII and the founding of Israel were watershed moments in our history, leading communities of disciples to form and ministries to develop, each of whom now has its own name and identity among locals, during the Covid-19 pandemic God has refreshed and strengthened our communities, helping them become places where people worship, work and bear witness together. When guests come, they often say, "There is a difference here. We don't know what it is. It's peaceful and we feel safe."

God is calling us to be these communities throughout the Land where people come and find the peace that we have found—the peace that passes understanding. It is our prayer, that through this booklet, you would consider partnering with us as we seek to fulfill God's calling through our work here in the Land.
