Why is a gift in my Will important to CMJ UK?

- It will help CMJ to continue its work of bringing the message of the Messiah to future generations of Jewish people.
- Over the last few years more than £1 in every £5 donated to us came from people who decided to pass something on to support our continuing work.
- Your legacy will be a blessing by helping to continue the work of CMJ here in the UK and in Israel.
- You'll be investing in God's future plans for His people.
- Leaving a legacy will help CMJ continue the work which mattered to you during your life.

Please let us know of your intention to leave CMJ UK a legacy.

To leave CMJ UK a legacy, draw up your will to reflect your wishes. This is best done through a solicitor to ensure that your will meets all legal requirements. It also makes it easy for your family and executors to know what your intentions are for your estate.

There are three ways in which you can make a gift. These are listed opposite.

A residuary legacy is the best way to minimise the effect of inflation and to avoid the usually high costs of dealing with a specific legacy.

If you wish to leave a legacy to a specific project, please include a clause which allows the gift to be used for similar projects in case the specific project you have in mind is closed. This will ensure that CMJ can use your gift even if the particular project you chose is no longer in existence.

Having chosen the type of legacy you wish to leave, pass the relevant standard wording provided on the opposite page to your solicitor.



A Residuary Legacy

This represents the residue of your estate after all other bequests have been followed.

"I give all (or a certain share of, if you wish to make more than one such bequest) the residue of my estate absolutely to The Vincent Society (trading as CMJ UK - The Church's Ministry among Jewish People), Eagle Lodge, Hexgreave Hall Business Park, Farnsfield, Nottinghamshire, NG22 8LS. Registered Charity No. 1153457 for its general purposes, and I direct that the receipt of the Treasurer or other duly authorised officer shall be sufficient discharge to my executors."

A Pecuniary Legacy

Use this option if you wish to leave a specified amount to CMJ.

I give The Vincent Society (trading as CMJ UK - The Church's Ministry among Jewish People), Eagle Lodge, Hexgreave Hall Business Park, Farnsfield, Nottinghamshire, NG22 8LS, Registered Charity No. 1153457, the sum of £(in figures) £(in words) for its general purposes and I direct that the receipt of the Treasurer or other duly authorised officer shall be sufficient discharge to my executors."

A Specific Legacy

Use this option if you wish to bequeath CMJ a specific item.

"I give The Vincent Society (trading as CMJ UK - The Church's Ministry among Jewish People), Eagle Lodge, Hexgreave Hall Business Park, Farnsfield, Nottinghamshire, NG22 8LS, Registered Charity No. 1153457, my (description of the item or items) absolutely for its general purposes and I direct that the receipt of the Treasurer or other duly authorised officer shall be sufficient discharge to my executors."
